MUSIC FESTIVAL – This week we have enjoyed the performances of our talented pupils who have taken part in poetry recitals, instrumental solos, singing solos, recorder ensembles and as a choir. Every child who took part received a certificate either as an individual or as a group and many received a distinction, some received a commendation and some a merit – all with very high scores. Two solo entries were awarded 1st place, our two recorder ensembles were awarded first and third place and our choir, of which 51 pupils took part, came third, missing second place by 1 mark. A fantastic experience was had by all and every child gained a sense of achievement. Well done to all involved for all your hard work preparing for this prestigious event. We look forward to further successes next year. We are also very grateful to the time Mrs Whomersley and Mrs Crouse have given so generously working with the recorder groups and the choir.
