

HOME-SCHOOL AGREEMENT

The school will:

- Promote each child's health, safety and happiness and encourage each child to do their best at all times
- Provide a broad and balanced curriculum, including extra-curricular opportunities, and meet the individual needs of each child
- Let parents know about any concerns or problems that affect their child's work, behaviour, attendance and punctuality
- Keep parents informed about general school matters and, in particular, their child's progress and arrange parents' evenings during which progress and 'targets' will be discussed
- Be open, welcoming and responsive at all times and offer opportunities for parents to become involved in the life of the school
- Encourage each child to take care of others around them and the school and its grounds.

Pupils will be expected to:

- Attend school regularly and on time
- Follow the Golden Rules: be gentle, be kind and helpful, work hard, look after property, listen to people and be honest
- Be polite, helpful and considerate to others and treat others as they would like to be treated
- Do all their classwork and homework as well as they can
- Wear the school uniform and be tidy in appearance
- Remember that they represent the school both inside and outside of it
- Keep the school free from litter and graffiti and take care of school property.

Parents will be expected to:

- See that their child attends school regularly, on time and properly dressed and equipped, and provide an explanation if their child is absent
- Avoid taking holidays in term time
- Make the school aware of any concerns or problems that might affect their child's work or behaviour
- Support the school's policies and guidelines.
- Support their child in homework and other opportunities for home learning
- Attend parents' evenings and discussions on their child's progress
- Get to know about their child's life in school.

If any pupil or parent does not consent to the terms of this agreement, they should put their concerns in writing to the headteacher.
