the no go I to


Your child should now be bringing home a reading book with words. It would be great if your child could start to spot the sounds taught so far and start to read the 'red' words. We still encourage the children to make up stories using the pictures and start to answer questions about what they can see.

Maths

Over the last few weeks we have been focussing on numbers 0-5. We have been finding out where these numbers sit on the number line, what each number looks like, how to form each number and making each number with different resources.



At home please could you support your child to recognise numbers 0-5 at random, place them in order, know one more and one less and represent the numbers using objects e.g., Lego pieces.

As the children are keen to have a go at writing the numbers I will send a number formation poster home, which has rhymes to help the children form their numbers. Please use the rhymes to remind the children how to form each number correctly.
