

- Advice and Guidance on the Team Around the Child Process (TAC)

The Early Help Hub is the single point of contact for professionals, families and young people to access Early Help Services in Cornwall.

The triage team decides which Early Help service best meets the needs identified in the request for help. It is then allocated to the appropriate service within 48 hours.

Support is provided: from pre-birth up to the age of 18, when the child, young person or family has needs that are not met solely by universal services (or 25 when young people have additional needs).
