## Fronted Adverbials

Sometimes an adverb or adverbial phrase can come before the verb instead of after.

Tom rode his bike **like an expert**.

Could be changed to:

**Like an expert**, Tom rode his bike.

A **comma** always comes after a **fronted adverbial**.

Here are some more examples...

Above the clouds,  
Below the sea,  
As quick as a flash,  
Without a sound,  
Unfortunately,

In the blink of an eye,  
Before long,  
Barely alive,  
Unexpectedly,  
Suddenly,
